bring security to my dwelling.

— Psalm 4:9

BELIEVING IN JESUS CHRIST

Throughout the Easter season, all three of the Sunday readings are taken from the New Testament—the Christian scriptures. Together they explore what it means to believe in Jesus as the Christ, the One who fulfilled the prophecies of the Jewish scriptures.

Today’s selections refer to our human weakness, yet they emphasize the forgiveness and peace that are available to those who put their faith in “Jesus Christ the righteous one” (1 John 2:2). In the Acts of the Apostles Peter invites everyone to “repent, therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be wiped away” (Acts 3:19). The First Letter of John calls Jesus Christ “expiation for our sins” (1 John 2:2). Finally, in the Gospel Jesus greets the disciples with “Peace” and urges them to preach “repentance, for the forgiveness of sins” (Luke 24:47).

A blessed Easter continues as I worshipped among you this morning. The wonderful welcoming environment, exceptional youth music ministry and the tempo and reverence of the Liturgy was heartwarming and released in me a joyful sense of God's presence.

It is in this spirit of joy that Fr. Mike made my future journey and ministry among you known. I am not new to Auburn or indeed to this parish. Forty-two years ago I came to Auburn to follow my religious vocation as a Sister of Mercy. Thirty something years ago I taught grades five and six at the old St. Joseph's school and often risked my life to keep the ball off the street! Twenty years ago I was principal here at the new school. Following that 10 years I ministered at the Diocesan office with Bishops Quinn and Weigand creating and implementing the Institute of Lay Ministry Formation. Most recently I've served in the Diocese of Reno, Nevada as Pastoral Life Administrator of Our Lady of the Snows Parish, .Reno has few priests so Bps. As I return now to St. Teresa's, it is just like coming home. In the meantime/spare time, I collected a few degrees in History, Political Science, a teaching certificate and an MA in Educational Administration. I spent three summers at Notre Dame studying Liturgy, and one summer at Creighton studying development and grant writing, Intertwined in all of this was years of theology, philosophy, spiritual practice and discernment.

It is my hope for all of us that we continue to grow in our Catholic faith-(womb to tomb)-plumb the true depths of its meaning, celebrate its connection with our everyday life and continue to welcome every one we meet as we carry out Easters Great Commission. "To go forth and teach/preach the good news to peoples of all nationalities, baptize them in the name of the Holy Trinity and we can do this because Jesus is with us always."
