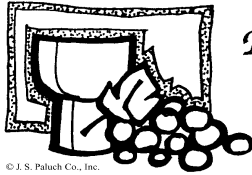

## **Allegory of the Vine**

Today's gospel is an allegory. In an allegory all the details have meaning. In a parable only the main point is intended for application to life. Today's gospel deserves prayerful reading and reflection. As the allegory of the vine is told, His followers hear many aspects of Christ's relationship with them. The pruning of the vine is applied to life. The need to prune branches so other branches can bear a fuller crop is part of life. The next point of the allegory is the truth that Christ is "home" for the disciple. Home is where you belong and where you come back to all the time. Every Sunday morning between the first two Masses I call home. I am looking forward to going home in July. Home is where I relax, and it helps give perspective to my life.

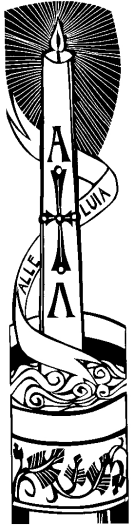
"Whoever remains in me, with me in Him, bears fruit in plenty." When we are so rooted in Christ we open our lives in practical love for others. No longer are our lives self-centered. As St. Paul said towards the end of his life, "It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me."

"You may ask what you will and you shall get it." According to this passage, the answer to pray is guaranteed—but note the condition: "If you remain in Me and My words remain you." Those who are close to Christ will only want the Divine will to be fulfilled. Last week at our final R.C.I.A gathering, one of our couples shared some poignant news. Their first statement was, "Why us Lord?" Their final statement was, "Why not us because we have love, love of each other, and the special love of Christ supporting us."

The last point of the allegory is the extension of the Glory of the Father. We are challenged to be His fruit-bearing disciples in our world today. Life is assured if we remain in Christ.

At this time of year when you are driving through the hills of Placer and El Dorado, and Amador, or driving through the Napa or the San Joaquin Valley, enjoy your blessings. Please God, the lessons of Christ from the allegory of the vine will also take root in your hearts.
