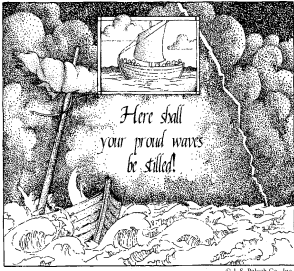

**SUFFERING**

Suffering is not something we should seek. Jesus did not seek suffering and Gethsemane makes that clear. Suffering will inevitably be part of the Christian life as it was part of Christ’s life. His followers will suffer for standing for the values He stood for, and associating with the people He associated with. St. Paul tells us when Christ assumed our condition, He put aside the glory that belonged to Him as the Son of God. It was His life Passion and Death in obedience to His father that led to glory.

The Late Christopher Reeve is remembered especially for his role as “Superman.” When the movie was first released, the question he was most frequently asked was “What is a hero?” The answers he gave then were as follows: “Someone who performs a courageous action without considering the consequences or a captured soldier who never stops trying to escape.” He also shared his heroes: Charles Lindbergh, John F. Kennedy and John Wayne.

In 1995 Reeve had an accident which left him paralyzed from the neck down. Then, he shared his new thoughts on what it is to be a hero, “A hero is someone who finds strength to keep going in spite of overwhelming obstacles, or a person who enables others to overcome these obstacles.”

When Christ said, “that the Son of man is destined to suffer grievously—, “Peter and the apostles did not want to accept that kind of Messiah. Jesus was revealed as the Messiah, but a suffering Messiah.

Suffering is a part of the lives of all Christians. We do not suffer alone because of Christ’s Presence and the presence of His followers.

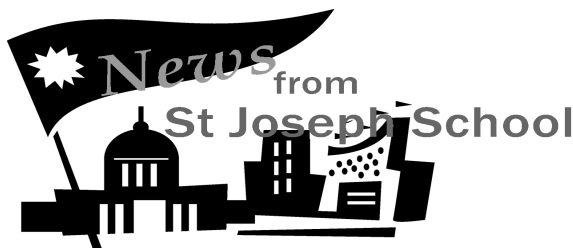
