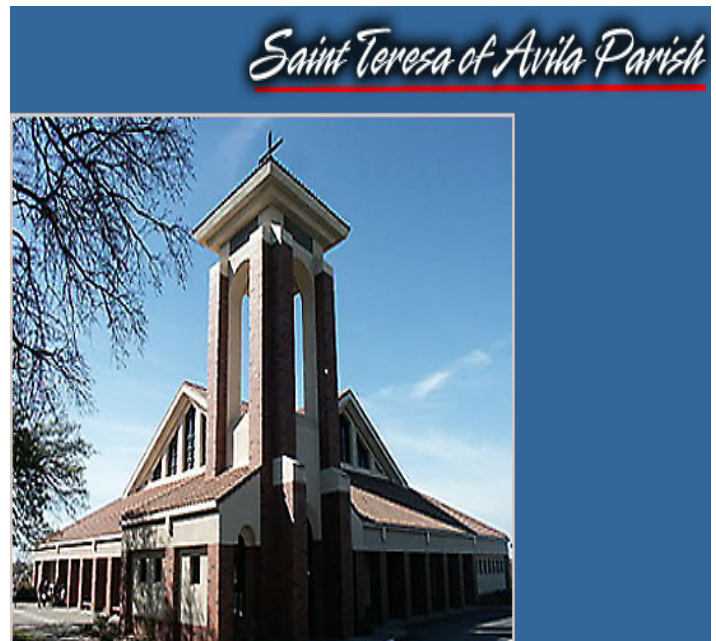
**Baptisms:** For the celebration of Baptism, please call the Parish Office, for information.

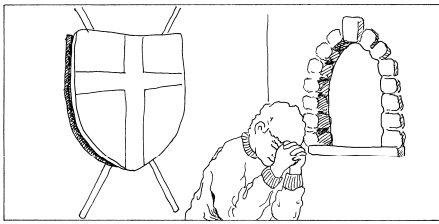

**GIVEN MUCH**

**R.C.I.A. Rite of Catholic Initiation for Adults**

Years ago I asked my Grandmother “What was the greatest day of your life so far?” Without hesitation she answered, “The day I got married, from that day on I felt your Grandfather loved me and wanted me.”

Blessed are each one of us, when we too realize how much we are loved and wanted by God. So much did God love us that He gave us His Son Jesus Christ. Christ told us how blessed is the wayward son, who is so loved and wanted by his Father. How happy is the lost sheep, to be wanted and searched for by the Shepherd.

Today we invite in Jesus’ name those who are searching for meaning in their lives. Maybe you have put off coming closer to Christ in His Church. We pray that God’s Holy Spirit is directing you towards the Catholic Church. Our R.C.I.A. program will help you walk with Christ and His Church. Deacon Dave Ford, Sr. Anita and I will teach the classes and help explain the truths of the Catholic Church.

I love sharing my love of God and the Catholic faith with family and with those who will become family through our community. Here at St. Teresa’s, instruction class (R.C.I.A.) will begin Monday, September 13th.

Last year towards the close of our first R.C.I.A class, I asked the question “What do you like about the Catholic Church?” When the first two people started to answer what they liked about St. Teresa of Avila community, I was going to repeat my question but I decided not to, because I was enjoying their insights into our parish. “I like St. Teresa’s because you don’t over dress for Church, it’s what is in the heart that matters”. “I like St. Teresa’s because of the reverence for the Presence of God.” “The people here are friendly, it’s like being with family.” “I was only in the parish a month when I volunteered, and I was called back immediately.” “I Like St. Teresa’s because my wife has quietly come here for many years, she left me the choice.” Each persons insight was unique and a source of God’s blessing for our community.

A few years ago in the Sacramento Bee there was a survey published about peoples church affiliation in the United States. There are close to 400,000 Catholics in the Sacramento region. I hope this is not going to make us complacent. Here, we are blessed with a special Presence of God and very good self sacrificing parishioners. We are the richer when every persons story is listened to. We are the poorer when the opposite is true. By our baptism we are called to be God’s people, each of us are the Catholic Church.

Maybe, this is the year to step forward and accept Christ’s invitation through St. Teresa’s community, to be part of the Body of Christ. You are loved and wanted, your presence will be your gift to God and His Church.
