You alone, O LORD, bring security to my dwelling.

— Psalm 4:9

**FULFILLMENT**

It is interesting that during the Easter season, when we do not hear a reading from the Old Testament, it becomes so important. This is particularly true today. Peter's speech begins with a prayer formula familiar to Jews: "The God of Abraham . . ." (Acts 3:13). It likewise contains the potent phrases "Holy and Righteous One" and "mouth of all the prophets" (3:14, 18). Peter was stating in no uncertain terms that the law, psalms, and prophets had been fulfilled in Christ. This is reinforced by Jesus himself in the Gospel passage, when he states that everything in the scriptures (to the early Christians "the scriptures" were what we call the Old Testament) had to be fulfilled. Above all, Jesus and Peter both emphasize that we are witnesses to all of this, and are sent forth to bear witness to it in the world. The Latin *Missa*, from which our word "Mass" comes, means "sent" (as in "mission"). As we leave Mass today, let us remember to be witnesses to all that has been fulfilled in the risen Christ.

## I WILL NEVER FORSAKE YOU

I always enjoy the Church bulletins that our parishioners bring back from their travels. Also, thank you for the short stories and the clean jokes that you share with me. Writing the pastor's notes each week has been a good discipline for me and I enjoy sharing parish updates and a story or two. My friend Betty S. shared the following story with me.

"The only survivor of a shipwreck was washed up on a small, uninhabited island. He prayed feverishly for God to rescue him, and every day he scanned the horizon for help, but none seemed forthcoming. Exhausted, he eventually managed to build a little hut out of driftwood to protect him from the elements, and to store his few possessions. But one day, after scavenging for food, he arrived home to find his little hut in flames, the smoke rolling up to the sky. The worst had happened; everything was lost. He was stunned with grief and anger. "God, how could you do this to me?" he cried. Early the next day, however, he was awakened by the sound of a ship that was approaching the island. It had come to rescue him. "How did you know I was here?" asked the weary man of his rescuers. "We saw your smoke signal," they replied."

It is easy to get discouraged when things are going bad. But we shouldn't lose heart, because God is at work in the lives of believers, even in the midst of pain and suffering. "Exhausto, finalmente logró construir una pequeña cabaña para protegerse de los elementos y almacenar sus pocas pertenencias. Pero un día después de rebuscar saqueos de alimentos, llegó a su casa para encontrar a su pequeña choza en llamas, el humo rodándose hacia el cielo. Lo peor había ocurrido, todo estaba perdido. **The Gospel of Mark**

Beginning April 18th and continuing for four weeks, Deacon Red Cheever will be teaching an adult religious education class on the Gospel of Mark. Scholars suggest that Mark was written in Rome around the year 70 A.D. The Jewish War was ending, and the Temple in Jerusalem was destroyed. Christians in Rome were suffering persecution; many Christians died in Circus Maximus because of their faith in Jesus, the Christ. The evangelist Mark, who was a friend/disciple of Peter, writes to both challenge and console the church in Rome. Mark remembers (in the Jewish sense—the past becomes present) the ministry, the Passion and the Resurrection of Jesus.

This story of Jesus, the Christ is our story today. We are not in ancient Rome, but still the story gives challenge and consolation. We read and study to become better Christians.

The classes will be held on April 18, 25, May 2nd and 4th, Wednesday, two sessions, 9:30—11am & 7-8:30pm. Bring your bible.
