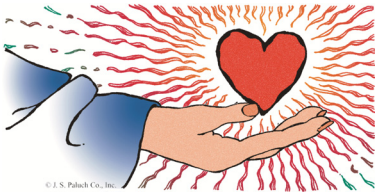

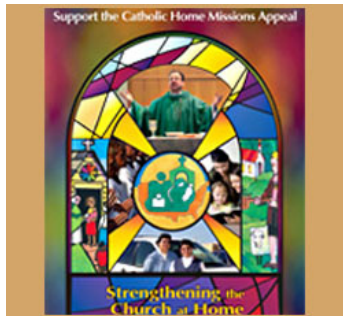

SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT de PAUL

Frederic Ozanam—Founder of the Society

The "Conference of Charity" from which the Society of St. Vincent de Paul sprang, was founded in Paris in April, 1833 by a few young men and a Catholic publicist. The principal founder was a man of twenty years of age, hailing from Lyons, named Frederic Ozanam.

A short time after his arrival in Paris, Ozanam found himself unexpectedly the center of a little group of Catholic students. The atmosphere after the July revolution was stormy.

Ozanam and his friends encountered one day, an objection flung in their teeth. "You praise the Church to us as the benefactor of humanity. That was true in former times, but what are you doing in our times for the people? What do you provide for them?" It was not enough to adore the God of the Gospel, it was necessary to follow Him. It was necessary to love and assist His children in need. Thereupon the students set up a "Conference of Charity".....(More next week)
